

Florida State Approved Initial Teacher Preparation Program Florida Teacher Certification Examination (FTCE)

Per Florida State Board of Education Rule 6A-5.066, candidates enrolled in a Florida state approved initial teacher preparation programs must pass all required Florida Teacher Certification Examinations in order to be endorsed as Florida state approved program completers. The table below provides the pass rates for the required exams for each program in the Anne Spenser Daves College of Education, Health, and Human Sciences. All candidates enrolled in programs approved at the bachelor's level must pass the following exams:

1. General Knowledge Examination
2. Professional Education Examination
3. Subject Area Examination

All candidates enrolled in programs approved at the master's or higher level, must pass the following exams:

1. Professional Education Examination
2. Subject Area Examination
